The Bellagio Center

Located in northern Italy, the Center provides an inspiring setting for exploring new ideas and finding solutions to some of the most difficult global problems. The Residency Program allows for disciplined work and collaborative action on these issues, uninterrupted by the usual professional and personal demands. Residency participants include scholars, scientists, artists, journalists, writers, non-governmental organization practitioners and policymakers from around the world.

Collegial interaction with the other residents is an integral dimension of the Bellagio experience. Meals and informal presentations of residents' work afford an opportunity for dynamic discussion and engagement with each other. During special dinners, residents may be able to interact with participants in international conferences hosted in various buildings on the Center's property.

The Center also offers collaborative residencies for two to four persons working on the same project. Creative artists in all fields and scholars in all disciplines from any country are welcome to apply. A residency is typically four weeks in length.

The Institute for International Education Latin America Office specifically is seeking for innovative **Scholars and Creative Artists from across Latin America** to participate.

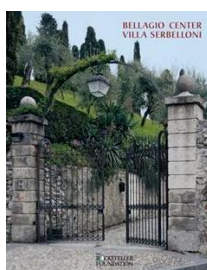
Benefits

- Residents will be housed for four weeks in the Bellagio Center
- Each resident is given a private room with a bath and a study/studio.
- High-speed Internet access is available free of charge in all bedrooms and most studies.
- A small library includes basic reference books and online research tools.

Selection Criteria

The Foundation seeks applications from scholars at all career stages with a record of significant achievement in their field. Decisions are based on:

- The quality of the proposed project,
- How innovative the project is and how likely it is to have broad impact or influence,
- The ability of the applicant to articulate the project's purpose and goals,
- The professional qualifications and achievements of the applicant, and
- The suitability and value of the Bellagio Center for the proposed activity.
- the match between the project and the Foundation's mission, and
- Personal qualities that are likely to make an applicant a contributing member of an international, interdisciplinary community—curiosity, breadth of interests, ability to honor other viewpoints and sensitivity to other cultures.



Application Deadline

The next deadline for the Bellagio Center competition for scholars and creative artists will be May 1, 2011, for a possible residency between February 1 and mid-August, 2012.
