




# Objetivo general de la asignatura

### Warm up

#### The Expert Game

# Another, other, others





# **Example**;

- I need another book. (book is singular so we use another)
- I need other books. (books is plural so we use other)
- I need others. (refers to other books)





(Countable and uncountable) Countable nouns are those that refer to something that can be counted. They have both singular and plural forms e.g. dog/dogs, woman/women, country/countries. In the singular, they can be preceded by a or an.

#### \*Review\*

A smaller number of nouns do not typically refer to things that can be counted and so they do not regularly have a plural form e.g. rain, flour, earth, wine or wood. Many abstract nouns are typically uncountable such as happiness, truth, darkness, humour.
