Interviewer: Oh! That's right1 Thanks for your attention.






Frequency Adverbs

%	Adverb of Frequency	Example
100%	Always	I always study after class
90%	Usually	I usually walk to work
80%	Normally / Generally	I normally get good marks
70%	Often / Frequently	I often read in bed at night
50%	Sometimes	I sometimes sing in the shower
30%	Occasionally	I occasionally go to bed late
10%	Seldom	I seldom put salt on my food
5%	Hardly ever / Rarely	I hardly ever get angry
0%	Never	Vegetarians never eat meat
Subject + Adverb + Main Verb Daniel always passes his exams. Subject + BE + Adverb He is always happy.		








Examples

I rarely have breakfast in the morning










hever / bed / he / early / goes / to

What?

It's used to ask about specific thing, people, animal, object.



Which?

It's used to ask about choice, alternative.



Where?

It's used to ask about place, position.



Who?

It's used to ask about people, person.



When?

It's used to ask about time, occasion, moment.



Whose?

It's used to ask about who the possessor of something.



Why?

It's used to ask about reason, explantion.



How?

It's used to ask about condition, quality, may, manner, form events and the way things.



Where did you go swimming? In the swimming pool in town.

Why did you go there? Because it's a nice, big pool.

Who did you go swimming with? With Amy.

What time did you meet Amy? At 10 o'clock.

Which pool did you go in? The serious one, without the slides!


