Tema:1.1. "Passive Voice Emphasizing facts"

"Simple present"

Passive voice is used when the focus is on the action. It is not important or not known, however, who or what is performing the action.

My brother eats an apple = The apple is eaten (by my brother)

SIMPLE PRESENT ACTIVE VOICE:

GIVES IMPORTANCE TO THE SUBJECT THAT MAKES AN ACTION.

EXAMPLE:

* PETER OPENS THE DOOR. (PETER IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE DOOR)

SIMPLE PRESENT

"PASSIVE VOICE"

GIVES IMPORTANCE TO THE OBJECT THAT RECEIVES AN ACTION.

EXAMPLES:

THE DOOR IS CLOSED (BY PETER).

SIMPLE PAST

ACTIVE VOICE:

GIVES IMPORTANCE TO THE SUBJECT THAT MAKES AN ACTION.

EXAMPLE:

* MY BROTHER ATE AN APPLE. (MY BROTHER IS MORE IMPORTANT THAN THE DOOR)

SIMPLE PAST

"PASSIVE VOICE"

GIVES IMPORTANCE TO THE OBJECT THAT RECEIVES AN ACTION.

EXAMPLE

MY BROTHER ATE AN APPLE = THE APPLE WAS EATEN (BY MY BROTHER)
