Introducción:

Will and going to:

Both refer to the future and there is a slight difference between the two though in most cases they can be used interchangeably with no difference in meaning.

Desarrollo del Tema:

Future with "will"

Use the future with will to talk about an event in the future that you have just decided to do, for predictions and for promises.

Ex.

- I think I'll go to that party next week.
- The economy will get better soon.
- Yes, I will marry you.

Future with Will Structure: Afirmative

Subject + will + verb.

I will study in Usa

Negative

Interrogative: (?)

Subject + will + not (won't) + verb.

I will not pass my English test

Will + subject + verb Question mar?

Will you marry me?

Future with "Going to".

The future with 'going to' is used to express events you have already **planned** in the future and your **intentions** for the future. We sometimes also use the present continuous for planned events in the **near future**.

Affirmative

Subject + (am- is - are) going to + verb. I am going to marry next month

Interrogative

(am- is- are) + subject + going to + verb Are you going to have kids?

Negative

Subject + (am - is - are) + not + going to +) + verb.

She is not going to pass math class
