## Present and past passive.

The passive form is more formal than the active and it is more common in written language. We often use the passive when we don't know, when it is obvious, or when we don't want so say who or what is responsible for the action.

## Present active

The active form is when we say or mention who performs the action.

Ex. Claudia cleans the floor.

As you can see, in the previous sentence we have a subject who does the action.

## Present passive

The passive form is when we say or mention by who the action is performed or only what happened to the subject of the action.

- The floor is cleaned by Claudia.
- The floor is cleaned.

As you can see, in the previous sentence we only mention what happened to the object.

## Past active form

The past active form is when we say or mention who performed the action.

Ex. Claudia cleaned the floor.

As you can see, in the previous sentence we have a subject who did the action.

## Past passive form

The past passive form is when we say or mention by who the action was performed or only what happened to the object of the action.

- The floor was cleaned by Claudia.
- The floor was cleaned.

As you can see, in the previous sentence we only mention what happened to the object.
