This edition's main topic is "Sustainable future" so these are the suggested core ideas:

- · Translation and interpretation as sustainable services;
- · The future of translation and interpretation after the COVID 19 pandemic;
- · The role of translators and interpreters in vaccine plans;
- · Is the transition of a translator to an interpreter and vice versa valid?
- · Challenges of a translator or interpreter in an adverse and unpredictable economic situation;
- · The voluntary work of a translator or interpreter in organisms that promote a sustainable world;
- · The role of Mexican Sign Language interpreters in a sanitary contingency;
- · Challenges of translators and interpreters of Indigenous Languages during a sanitary contingency;
- · The evolution of audiovisual translation.

- -Round Table Discussion (with a maximum of 3 participants)

- Presentation: 50 minutes.
- Round Table Discussion: 50 minutes;
